 - Literacy created nonfiction books on space topics

School Budget

- Our school received \$2,257,779 from Provincial Budget in 2024-25 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan. Within this budget, Ramsay School was able to employ 14.6 FTE teachers, 3.7 FTE support staff, 3.3 FTE Admin staff as well as fund \$100,477 for supplies and other expenses.
- At this time, Parent Association covers all fees for school events, field trips and class activities. Families will be consulted with for proposed activities for the upcoming year that may require a fee for cost recovery. This does not include CBE fees such as bussing, etc.
